 - 1. Raise awareness of ADA
 - 2. Raise money
 - Money serves several causes
 - Helps disabled to find and keep a job
 - The fund especially help educate employers
 - Each dollar raised is matched by 4 more dollars from a state grant
 - Educate disable kids in high school so that they can pursue a profession
 - Money is due on the day of the event
 - Scoring will be done differently than from in the past; additionally, each team will receive an extra point per \$100 they raise
 - More teams have been invited this year, including more high schools.
