 - Error in last half mile on West and North
 - Original had 1.5 foot error
 - Peer Committee approves
 - Section 5
 - Evidence of 2 C.O.S. @ occupation
 - Also found pipe on South side of monument box @ $\frac{1}{4}$ line int.
 - Accepted pipe
 - Section 6
 - 5 Corners
 - Evidence of 4 different C.O.S. not @ $\frac{1}{4}$ lines, 1 at intersection
 - Sec. 7
 - Found 2 irons, both set from witnesses?
 - Found evidence of stump to choose the correct one
 - Sec. 8 “Picture perfect”
 - Sec. 9
 - Broken concrete monument
 - Spin iron and pull straight up, reset in hole for best position
 - LCRC
 - Indicate where the information was found so it may be found later
 - Follow in the footsteps of the original surveyor
 - Area being surveyed
 - How close is close enough?
 - Survey deed?
 - Hold found iron?
